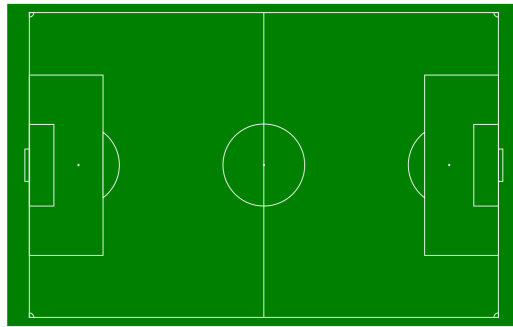

Our fundraising campaign continues. We're very keen to complete the new football pitch in the coming months, while continuing to raise money to meet the construction costs.

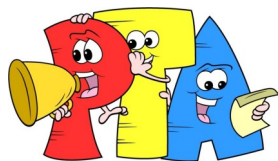
There are so many ways you can support this wonderful project and help us realise our dream. See below:
